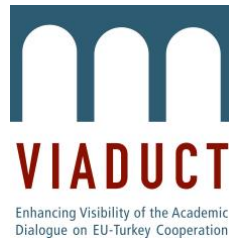

VIADUCT Teachers' Training Seminar

Charles University, Prague

30 May – 1 June 2018

The VIADUCT consortium invites applications for a Teachers' Training Seminar, which will be organised at Charles University on 30 May – 1 June 2018. The seminar will bring together teachers and lecturers with different disciplinary and national backgrounds from the VIADUCT network partner institutions. The aim is to exchange best practices and build a network of teachers by discussing teaching and learning strategies for courses dealing with EU-Turkey relations, and by refining existing teaching curricula. Approximately 15 teachers and lecturers from all over the EU and the neighbourhood are expected to participate in the seminar.

The seminar will be connected to the 3rd European Conference on Teaching and Learning Politics, International Relations and European Studies ([EuroTLC 2018](#)). Participants will have the opportunity to attend the conference panels and other events, following the latest advances in the research on and practice of teaching and learning delivered by professionals from all over Europe and beyond. Applicants are encouraged to apply independently for the EuroTLC 2018 with a relevant contribution.

Seminar costs:

The VIADUCT network will be able to cover the travel and accommodation costs for the selected participants.

How to apply:

Applications containing the name, institution, email address, discipline, overview of up to three latest relevant courses offered, and a short cover letter should be sent via email to Dr Tomáš Weiss, Charles University (weiss@fsv.cuni.cz) by **15 January 2018**.

The cover letter should explain how the participation in the seminar would potentially improve the applicant's teaching and what he/she expects to gain during the seminar.
