# **RADAR PUBLIC DEBATE & YOUTH LAB DISINFORMATION ON LGBTQIA+ PERSONS**

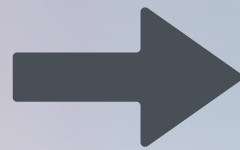
**6 October 2023, Kraków**

Applicants must have a residency in a Member State of the European Union;

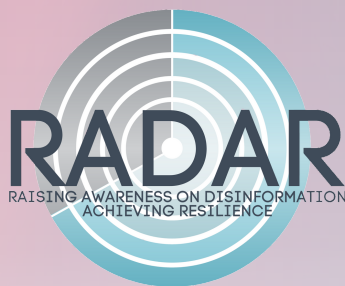
Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in English.
